Vsebina:

Seminar je neposredno podrejen cilju končne priprave doktorske disertacije. Temelji na predstavljanju, zagovarjanju in kritičnem reflektiranju osnutkov disertacij.

Študent(ka) k seminarju pristopi z vsaj delnim prvim osnutkom doktorske disertacije, ki mora vključevati najmanj:

- jasno formulirano raziskovalno vprašanje in hipoteze,
- predstavitev uporabljenih raziskovalnih metod,
- vsaj preliminarne raziskovalne rezultate,
- interpretacijo raziskovalnih rezultatov v luči hipotez,
- utemeljitev inovativnosti doktorske disertacije kot relevantnega prispevka k znanstvenemu znanju.

Izpolnjeni osnutek mora z danimi relevantnimi pripombami in sugestijami služiti kot zadostna podlaga za pripravo končnega besedila doktorske disertacije. Če mentor oceni, da tudi izpopolnjeni osnutek besedila tega še ne omogoča, mora študent(ka) seminar kot celoto opravljati ponovno.

Content (Syllabus outline):

The seminar is directly related to the objective of the final preparation of the doctoral dissertation. It is based on representation, advocacy and critical reflection on the draft theses.

The student approaches to the seminar with first draft of the doctoral dissertation which must include at least:

- clearly formulated research question and hypothesis,
- a presentation of the research methods,
- preliminary research results,
- interpretation of the research results,
- support of innovative doctoral dissertation as a relevant contribution to scientific knowledge.

The completed draft must serve as a sufficient basis for the preparation of the final text of the doctoral dissertation. If the supervisor considers that the improved draft text does not provide this, the student has to repeat the seminar.

Cilji in kompetence:

Predmet je namenjen poglobljanju znanja in spretnosti, ki omogoča lasten prispevek k razvoju sociologije na najvišji ravni, vključno s sintezo novih in kompleksnih idej

Objectives and competences:

The course aims to the acquisition of in-depth knowledge that enables an independent contribution to the development of sociology at the highest level, including a synthesis of new and complex ideas.

Prispeva k pridobitvi splošnih kompetenc:

- sposobnost avtonomnega identificiranja danega raziskovalnega problema, njegove analize ter možnih rešitev;
- izrazito avtonomno ustvarjanje novega znanja, ki pomeni relevanten prispevek k razvoju znanosti;
- sposobnost obvladanja standardnih metod, postopkov in procesov raziskovalnega dela na področju sociologije;
- sposobnost samostojnega raziskovalno-razvojnega dela za ustvarjanje, interpretiranje in iskanje odgovorov na abstraktna in najbolj kompleksna vprašanja v znanosti in stroki;
- poznavanje pomena kakovosti in prizadevanje za kakovost strokovnega dela skozi avtonomnost, (samo)kritičnost, (samo)refleksivnost in (samo)evalviranje v strokovnem delu;
- zavezanost profesionalni etiki, ki vključuje visoko razvito zmožnost odgovornega presojanja posledic uporabe novega znanja v različnih kontekstih.

Omogoča pridobitev predmetno specifičnih kompetenc:

- sposobnost za avtonomno reševanje konkretnih raziskovalnih problemov, vključno z najbolj kompleksnimi vprašanji, na različnih področjih sociologije in njej sorodnih disciplin;
- razvoj veščin in spretnosti v uporabi znanja na raziskovalnem področju sociologije ter sorodnih disciplin;
- sposobnost operacionalizacije abstraktnih teoretskih konceptov na visoki ravni zahtevnosti;
- formulacija in sposobnost zagovarjanja raziskovalnega načrta na najvišji zahtevnostni ravni;

It contributes to the acquisition of general competences:

- the ability to identify autonomously the given research problem, its analysis and possible solutions;
- strongly autonomous creation of new knowledge, which implies a significant contribution to the development of science;
- the ability to master standard methods, procedures and processes of research work in the field of sociology;
- the ability of autonomous research-developmental work to create, interpret and search for answers to the abstract and most complex questions in science and expertise;
- the familiarity with the significance of quality assurance and striving for quality of expert work by the means of autonomy, (self)critique, (self)reflectivity and (self)evaluation in the expert work;
- the commitment to professional ethics, which includes a highly developed ability to evaluate responsibly the consequences of the application of new knowledge in various contexts.
