**Cilji in kompetence:**

**Objectives and competences:**

Acquisition of in-depth knowledge that enables:

- achieving results at home and in the international space, especially in the framework of sociological and broader social science community, related to one's own scientific and expert work.

Acquisition of skills, necessary for:

- critical reflection with in-depth and abstract thinking;

Pridobitev splošnih kompetenc:

- razumevanje koncepta vraščenosti (embeddedness) in delovanja ekonomskih akterjev v okviru socialnih struktur;
- poznavanje in ustrezno ovrednotenje neekonomskih vplivov na ekonomske procese.

Acquisition of general competences:

- understanding the concept of embeddedness and the actions of economic actors in the context of the social structures;
- knowledge of and proper evaluation of the non-economic impacts on the economic processes.
